

Summary of Ordinance No. 3234

On May 13, 2013, the City of Abilene, Kansas, adopted Ordinance No. 3234. An Ordinance amending the future land use map as described in the comprehensive plan, designating lot 11 of Carl Addition and the South 35 feet of Lot 1 Carl Addition No. 3 from low density residential potential to multi-family potential. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE FUTURE LAND USE MAP AS DESCRIBED IN THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, DESIGNATING LOT 11 OF CARL ADDTION AND THE SOUTH 35 FEET OF LOT 1, CARL ADDITION NO. 3 FROM LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL POTENTIAL TO MULTI-FAMILY POTENTIAL

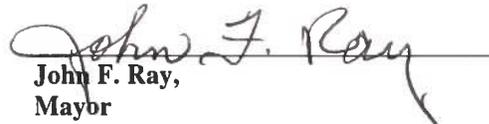
Be it Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Abilene, Kansas, that:

Section 1. That the boundaries incorporating multi-family potential as depicted on the map titled "Future Land Use City of Abilene, Kansas" are amended to include the following described real property:

LOT 11 OF CARL ADDTION AND LOT 1, CARL ADDITION NO. 3

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective upon its publication in the official city newspaper.
