

ORDINANCE NO. 3230

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE REZONING OF LAND FROM "B-3" HIGHWAY BUSINESS DISTRICT TO "R-1" SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT; AMENDING THE CURRENT DISTRICT ZONING MAP; ALL TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Governing Body of the City of Abilene, Kansas:

SECTION 1. The District Zoning Map of the City of Abilene, Kansas, adopted by Ordinance No. 2796 with all amendments thereto, is hereby amended as follows:

The boundary of the "R-1" Single Family Residential District is hereby amended to include the following described real property:

**Lots One (1) through Seven (7); Block 1, Dawson's Cottage Addition to the City of Abilene.**

SECTION 2. A public hearing was conducted by the Planning Commission of the City of Abilene on May 14, 2013 and a recommendation was made to the Governing Body to approve the rezoning of the above referenced property.


