

RESOLUTION NO. 061013-1

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PREPARATION AND SUBMITTAL OF A FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION GRANT APPLICATION BY OLSSON ASSOCIATES FOR THE ABILENE MUNICIPAL AIRPORT RUNWAY PROJECT AS RECOMMENDED BY THE AIRPORT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene, Kansas, has the legal authority to apply for, receive, and administer federal, state, and other monies through its Home Rule authority under the Constitution of the State of Kansas and authorized by K.S.A. 12-1662, regarding the expenditure of federal aid to public agencies; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to submit an application to the Federal Aviation Administration for funds to renovate the Abilene Municipal Airport Runway as recommended by the Airport Advisory Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Abilene, as follows:

Section 1. Application Authorization. That the City of Abilene, Kansas, does hereby authorize the City Manager to submit an application to the Federal Aviation Administration for the rehabilitation of the Abilene Municipal Airport Runway, AIP Project No. 3-20-0001-009, (“Project”) on behalf of the citizens of the City of Abilene.

Section 2. Project Scope. The scope of such Project shall be a Mill and Concrete Overlay of the Abilene Municipal Airport Runway 17/35, as recommended by the Airport Advisory Committee at its June 3, 2013 meeting.

Section 3. Sufficient Funding; Local Match. That the City hereby assures the Federal Aviation Administration that sufficient funding for the local match for the Project is anticipated to be available.

Section 4. Sufficient Funding; Operation and Maintenance. That the City hereby assures the Federal Aviation Administration that sufficient funding for the operation and maintenance of the Abilene Municipal Airport Runway will be available for the life of the Project.

Section 5. Official Representative. That the City Manager is authorized to sign the application to the Federal Aviation Administration for the Project on behalf of the citizens of the City of Abilene. The City Manager is also authorized to submit additional information or documentation as may be required and act as the official representative of the City in this and subsequent related activities.

Section 6. Project Administration. That the City hereby assures the Federal Aviation Administration that the City will contract with Olsson Associates to provide for the administration of all activities involved with the Project if selected for funding. Olsson Associates is hereby authorized to prepare such documents as may be required to submit the application for the Project to the Federal Aviation Administration.

Section 7. Effective Date. That the effects of this Resolution shall be in full force after its approval by the City Commission.
