


Summary of Ordinance No. 3239

ORDINANCE NO. 3239

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES, EDITION OF 2013

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene wishes to adopt by reference, under the provisions of K.S.A. 12-3009 through 12-3012, and K.S.A. 12-3301 and 12-3302, the Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities, Edition of 2013.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Incorporating Uniform Public Offense Code. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating public offenses within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, Kansas, that certain code known as the Uniform Public Offense Code, Edition of 2013, prepared and published in book form by the League of Kansas Municipalities, Topeka, Kansas. One official copy of said Uniform Public Offense Code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. 3239," and to which shall be attached a copy of this Ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours.

SECTION 2. Repeal. Ordinance No. 3200 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective and in full force from and after its passage, adoption and publication in the official City newspaper.
