

**RESOLUTION NO. 102813-4**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR THE KANSAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION GRANT BY THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS, TO PARTIALLY FUND THE CITY'S PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene operates a public transportation service that benefits the citizens of Abilene;

**WHEREAS**, such public transportation services have been subsidized by grant funding from the Kansas Department of Transportation in order for such services to be affordable to users and at minimum cost to Abilene taxpayers; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene desires to continue the operation of its public transportation services to provide the public with options for transportation within and throughout the community.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Commission of the City of Abilene, Kansas, as follows:

**Section 1. Support of Grant Application**. That the City Commission hereby declares its support for a Public Transportation Grant from the Kansas Department of Transportation to assist with the funding of the City's public transportation services.

**Section 2. Sufficient Funding; Local Match**. That the City hereby assures the Kansas Department of Transportation that sufficient funding for the local match will be available, and that the City has budgeted funding sufficient for vehicle replacement as required by the KDOT Purchase Replacement Capital portion of the request.

**Section 3. Official Representative**. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign the application to the Kansas Department of Transportation on behalf of the citizens of the City of Abilene. The City Manager and the Parks and Recreation Director are hereby authorized to execute and submit additional information or documentation as may be required and to act as the official representatives of the City in the administration of this program.

**Section 4. Submission**. The City Clerk, or designee, is hereby authorized to submit the appropriate documentation as evidence of the City of Abilene's support for the application of a KDOT Public Transportation Grant.

**Section 5. Effective Date**. That the effects of this Resolution shall be in full force after its approval by the City Commission.
