

ORDINANCE NO. 3251

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-203(h) OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS, CONCERNING ANNUAL LICENSURE OF CONTRACTORS ENGAGED IN THE REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT OF ROOFING MATERIALS

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Section 2-203(h) of the City Code of the City of Abilene is hereby amended to read as follows:

A roof permit shall be required for all projects involving the removal and replacement of roofing materials. A new permit shall be required for each separate project, with fees as prescribed in the City of Abilene Comprehensive Fee Schedule. All roofing contractors must register with the City of Abilene and obtain a license to operate as a roofing contractor in the City of Abilene. This license is renewed annually beginning on July 31st, 2015 with fees as prescribed in the City of Abilene Comprehensive Fee Schedule. All roofing contractors must show proof of certification through the State of Kansas Attorney General's office. No person shall engage in business as a roofing contractor without filing with the City evidence of a current policy of public liability insurance in the following amounts: *(Ord 3162 9/10)*

- (1) Three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) for bodily injury liability;
- (2) Three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00) for the loss, destruction or injury of any property;
- (3) Automobile liability insurance in the amount of (\$300,000.00).

Such policy shall be conditioned or extended to cover and include within its terms all employees, assistants and agents of the insured.

SECTION 2. Repeal. Existing Section 2-203(h) is hereby repealed. All other sections of Chapter 2, Article 2 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, signature and publication in the official city newspaper as provide by law.
