

RESOLUTION NO. 052714-2

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING ITS PUBLIC SALE OR DISPOSAL

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 12-101 grants cities the authority to “sell and convey any real or personal estate owned by the city;”

WHEREAS, the City does not have a specific policy concerning the designation of surplus property and its disposal or sale;

WHEREAS, the following items of City-owned property have served their useful life for the City of Abilene’s purposes and needs and are no longer being used or operated by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City does not anticipate using or operating said property at any time in the future.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the City of Abilene, Kansas that:

Section 1. Designation of Surplus Property. The City Commission hereby designates the City-owned property as described in **Exhibit A**, attached hereto, as surplus property to be publicly sold or otherwise disposed of.

Section 2. Designation of Seller. The City Commission hereby designates Purple Wave, Inc. of Manhattan, Kansas, as the official seller of City-owned surplus property.


Section 3. Implementation. The City Manager is hereby authorized to sell the aforementioned surplus property and to return said proceeds to the appropriate public funds for the purchase of future vehicles and equipment as may be needed by the City for its operations. The sale of any property designated as surplus shall be done in compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, resolutions, or policies.

Section 4. Public Notice. The City Manager shall provide notice to the public in the official newspaper and on the City website of the date and time of any public sale organized by the Designated Seller. Such notice shall be at least fourteen days in advance of the official start of the sale.

Section 5. Effective Date. That the effects of this Resolution shall be in full force after its approval by the City Commission.
