

RESOLUTION NO. 051214-3

A RESOLUTION APPROVING ANNUAL APPOINTMENTS TO BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS

WHEREAS, Article 8 of Chapter 1 of the City Code of the City of Abilene establishes certain appointed boards and commissions for the City of Abilene, Kansas;

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene appoints members to said boards and commissions each year in May;

WHEREAS, serving on appointed boards and commissions provides members of the public to serve their community in a unique and appreciated manner.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Abilene, as follows:

Section 1. Annual Appointments. That the following appointments are made to various boards and commissions of the City of Abilene, Kansas:

- Kyle Campbell to the Airport Advisory Committee with a term ending 2017;
- Johnny Kinder to the Board of Zoning Appeals with a term ending 2017;
- Jeff Sheets, Mukul Gosh, Mary Jane Oard, and Sharon Peterson to the Convention and Visitors Bureau with a term ending 2017;
- Larry Coulson, Joleen Rankin, and Chris West to the Economic Development Council with terms ending 2017;
- Dennis Medina, Jeff Sheets, and Amy Feigley to the Heritage Commission with terms ending 2017;
- Kyler Schardein, Elliott Kobiskie, and Allie Hiatt to the Kids' Council with terms ending 2016;
- Tim Shafer and Teresa Weishaar to the Library Board with terms ending 2018;
- Kyle Campbell and Michelle Stevens to the Planning Commission with terms ending 2017;
- Jack Gilstrap and Jacob Hawk to the Tree Board with terms ending 2017;

Section 2. Guidelines for Operations. Appointed boards and commissions shall follow the guidelines for appointed boards and commissions as defined by Section 1-813 and 1-814 of the City Code. The City Manager, or the designated staff representative, shall provide an orientation for new members of appointed boards and commissions.

Section 3. Recognition for Service. The City of Abilene wishes to recognize those who have served on its appointed boards and commissions that will not be continuing their service. The City Manager shall have prepared a Certificate of Service to be signed by the Mayor to be provided to each member resigning from their board or commission. The following citizens are hereby recognized for their contributions and service to the City of Abilene:

- Stewart Etherington from the Heritage Commission;
- Maggie Gillespie, Robbie Kenner, Kiley McKinney, Nathaniel Tompkins, and Matigan Kobiskie from the Kids' Council;
- Julie Beswick and LaVetra Brown from the Library Board; and
- Aaron Christner and John Kollhoff from the Planning Commission.

Section 4. Sister City Committee. That the appointments to the Sister City Committee will be tabled until the next regular meeting of the City Commission.


Section 5. Effective Date. That the effects of this Resolution shall be in full force after its approval by the City Commission.
