

RESOLUTION NO. 030915-1

A RESOLUTION MAKING CERTAIN APPOINTMENTS TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION TO FILL AN UNEXPIRED TERM ENDING IN MAY 2017

WHEREAS, Article 8 of Chapter 1 of the City Code of the City of Abilene establishes certain appointed boards and commissions for the City of Abilene, Kansas;

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene appoints members to said boards and commissions each year in May;

WHEREAS, a Planning Commission member has resigned and created a vacancy on said commission; and

WHEREAS, serving on appointed boards and commissions provides members of the public to serve their community in a unique and appreciated manner.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Abilene, as follows:

Section 1. Appointment. That the following appointments are made to various boards and commissions of the City of Abilene, Kansas:

- Rod Boyd to the Planning Commission with a term ending in May 2017.

Section 2. Guidelines for Operations. Appointed boards and commissions shall follow the guidelines for appointed boards and commissions as defined by Section 1-813 and 1-814 of the City Code. The City Manager, or the designated staff representative, shall provide an orientation for new members of appointed boards and commissions.


