

RESOLUTION NO. 032315-2

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS TO THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS

WHEREAS, the Water Treatment Plant had not originally been designed to accommodate the fluoridation of the public water supply;

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene had determined that significant corrosion had occurred in the Fluoride Room at the Water Treatment Plant causing safety concerns for City employees;

WHEREAS, the City decided to temporarily discontinue the fluoridation of the public water supply until such time as the corrosion and safety concerns of the Fluoride Room were properly addressed; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to facilitate improvements to the Water Treatment Plant to allow for the continuation of fluoridation of the City's public water supply in conformance with Ordinance No. 2828.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Abilene, as follows:

SECTION ONE. Policy Direction. The City Commission hereby directs and authorizes the City Manager to take such actions as may be necessary and appropriate to provide for the safe application of fluoride to the public water supply in conformance with Ordinance No. 2828, as attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

SECTION TWO. Implementation. The City Manager shall be authorized to enforce the provisions as provided herein, and in applicable resolutions, ordinances, and laws. The City Manager shall provide a monthly progress report on the status of the implementation of this Resolution to the City Commission.

SECTION THREE. Effective Date. That the effects of this Resolution shall be in full force after its approval by the City Commission.

ORDINANCE NO. 2828

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE FLUORIDATION OF
THE WATER PROVIDED BY THE MUNICIPAL WATER UTILITY.**

Be It Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Abilene, Kansas, that:


Section 1. In order to protect and promote the health of the residents of the City of Abilene, Kansas, the fluoridation of the water provided by the municipal water utility is hereby authorized and directed.

Section 2. The amount and method of fluoridation shall be consistent with all applicable state and federal regulations, as well as standards generally recognized and accepted by the medical and dental professions.

Section 3. Fluoridation of the water provided by the municipal water utility shall commence at the earliest feasible time after the completion of the municipal water treatment plant.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be effective upon publication in the official city newspaper.
