

RESOLUTION NO. 111416-1

A RESOLUTION STATING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY OF ABILENE TO PARTICIPATE IN A JUSTICE CENTER PROPOSED BY DICKINSON COUNTY, KANSAS

WHEREAS, the governing body, with the adoption of Resolution No. 080816-3, elected to participate in Dickinson County's Justice Center Study completed by Goldberg Group Architects, PC, ("Consultant") to determine the cost of the City's participation and other options that may be advantageous for the governing body's consideration;

WHEREAS, the governing body desires to make a good faith effort to participate in the Justice Center ("Project") with Dickinson County after careful review and consideration of the options prepared by the Consultant; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to affirm its intent made by Resolution No. 091415-4, to eventually proceed with the development of a plan for other public facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Abilene, as follows:

SECTION ONE. Findings. The governing body hereby finds that it is in the City's best interests to participate in the development of the Project to include the Abilene Police Department and the Abilene Municipal Court.


