

RESOLUTION NO. 021317-1

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN AD HOC COMMITTEE TO MAKE CERTAIN RECOMMENDATIONS CONCERNING PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE FLOOD INSURANCE RATE MAP TO BE PREPARED FOR THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS

WHEREAS, Article 8 of Chapter 1 of the City Code of the City of Abilene (“City”) establishes certain appointed boards and commissions and provides for the creation of ad hoc committees as may be necessary for the City of Abilene, Kansas;

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to review and make recommendations on proposed amendments to the Flood Insurance Rate Maps for the City;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1-814 of the City Code, the City Commission desires to establish an ad hoc committee to review and prepare recommendations on the aforementioned subject.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Abilene, as follows:

SECTION ONE. Ad Hoc Committee; Flood Insurance Rate Maps. That the City hereby establishes an ad hoc committee, to be known as the Flood Insurance Rate Map Committee (hereinafter “Committee”), to review the proposed recommendations to the Flood Insurance Rate Maps of the City.

SECTION TWO. Appointments; Public Facilities. That the following appointments are hereby made to the Committee: Bob Bow, Rod Markley, Teresa Griffin, Diane Ingram, and Cybil Luea.

SECTION THREE. Officers. The Committee shall select a Chair and Vice-Chair from its membership. The Chair shall be responsible for overseeing meetings of the Committee, and the Vice-Chair shall fulfill this duty when the Chair is unable to do so.

SECTION FOUR. Staff Liaison. The Community Development Director will serve as the official City Liaison to the Committee, although other staff members may be solicited for input.

SECTION FIVE. Public Information. All meetings of the Committee shall be conducted in conformance with the Kansas Open Meetings Act, and all information created by or on behalf of the Committee shall be made available to the general public on the City’s website. Agendas for the meeting will be published in advance of Committee meetings, and meeting minutes will be maintained for the public record. The City Manager shall be responsible for ensuring that the provisions of this Section are fulfilled.

SECTION SIX. Budget. The Committee shall not have any budgetary authority and does not have any funds appropriated to facilitate its purpose. The City Commission may appropriate such funds as may be necessary for the Committee to fulfill its responsibilities as it may deem appropriate.

SECTION SEVEN. Effective Date. That the effects of this Resolution shall be in full force after its approval by the City Commission.
