**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS, ESTABLISHING THE CITY COMMISSION'S 2018-2019 PRIORITIES.**

WHEREAS, The City's Governance and Ends Policies provides that "The City Commission will carry out its job with discipline, emphasizing strategic rather than tactical issues, policy rather than single events, and group rather than individual decisions;" and

WHEREAS, The Comprehensive Plan has not been updated since 2006 and the City's Capital Improvement Plan is in the process of clarification as it according to policy establishes the City's priorities for public projects based on available financial resources and project criteria; and

WHEREAS, It is the duty and responsibility of the City Manager to recommend workable plans for the City improvements and future developments, and the City Manager has provided a prioritization exercise to ensure a strategic approach.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS:**


**SECTION 1.** The City Commission establishes the following priorities for 2018-19:

  2. Downtown Development/Beautification
  3. Welcome Sign
  4. Sidewalks/Walkability
- **Policy**
  1. Land Bank Plan/Policy
  2. Retail Recruitment
  3. Code Enforcement Program
- **Infrastructure**
  1. Storm Water Plan
  2. Street Maintenance Plan
  3. Water Source
- **Equipment**
  1. Fire Engine replacement
  2. Funding Equipment Reserve
