

ORDINANCE NO. 18-3367

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1-906 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS, CONCERNING THE AD HOC ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT TASK FORCE WITHIN THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE. Section 1-906 of the City Code of the City of Abilene, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

1-906. Economic development task force.

The Economic Development Task Force may be appointed by the Governing Body on an ad hoc basis in accordance with section 1-902(b). The Task Force shall meet at such times determined by the City Manager.

The Economic Development Task Force shall provide policy and program advice and recommendations to promote the economic interests of the City and make recommendations to the Governing Body regarding local economic development initiatives. The Task Force may also conduct such other duties as may be assigned by the City Commission.


SECTION TWO. Existing Section 1-906 of the City Code of the City of Abilene, Kansas is hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication once in the official city newspaper by the following summary:


Ordinance No. 18-3367 Summary

On November 13, 2018, the City Commission passed Ordinance No. 18-3367. The ordinance amends Chapter 1, Article 9 of the City Code of the City of Abilene, Kansas, by amending section 1-906 to replace the Economic Development Council with an Economic Development Task Force, to be appointed by the City Commission on an ad hoc basis.
