

RESOLUTION 020821-1

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF A PLAN PURSUANT TO THE NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene, Kansas, may, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-17, 114 et seq., adopt a plan to assist in the rehabilitation, conservation, or redevelopment of any area within the City of Abilene which meets the conditions provided in said law.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Abilene, Kansas:

Section 1: That a public hearing shall be held by the Governing Body of the City of Abilene, Kansas to consider the adoption of a revised Neighborhood Revitalization Plan. The following notice is hereby given:

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The City Commission will consider the adoption of a revised Neighborhood Revitalization Plan at a public hearing at 4:00 p.m. on February 22, 2021 at the Abilene Public Library Commission Room, 209 NW 4th St., Abilene, Kansas.

The proposed Neighborhood Revitalization Plan and a description of the boundaries of the proposed Neighborhood Revitalization Areas are available for inspection during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. in the office of the City Clerk, Abilene City Hall, 419 N. Broadway, Abilene, Kansas.

At the conclusion of the hearing, the City Commission of the City of Abilene will consider findings necessary for the adoption of the proposed Neighborhood Revitalization Plan and the designation of the proposed Neighborhood Revitalization Areas, all as provided for in K.S.A. 12-17, 114 et seq.

Section 2: That the City Clerk shall cause a copy of this resolution to be delivered to the other taxing entities within the City of Abilene, Dickinson County, Kansas.

Section 3: That the City Clerk shall cause the notice in Section 1 of this resolution to be published in the official city newspaper at least once each week for two consecutive weeks prior to the hearing.

Section 4: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.
