

CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 27

A CHARTER ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS REPEALING CHARTER ORDINANCE NO. 26, A CHARTER ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS EXEMPTING THE CITY FROM THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 79-41a04(d), AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE PROVISIONS CONCERNING THE EXPENDITURE AND USE OF LOCAL ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene, Kansas did at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Abilene City Commission on the 24th day of April 2017 adopt Charter Ordinance 26 exempting the City of Abilene from the provisions of K.S.A. 79-41a04(d), and providing substitute provisions concerning the expenditure and use of Local Alcoholic Liquor funds; and

WHEREAS, upon further consideration the governing body of the City of Abilene has determined exempting the City of Abilene from the provisions of K.S.A. 79-41a04(d) does not serve the best interest of the community at this time, SO, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS;

Section 1. Charter Ordinance No. 27 repealing Charter Ordinance No. 26 as adopted by the governing body of the City of Abilene on April 24, 2017 is hereby adopted.

Section 2. This Charter Ordinance shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official city newspaper.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Charter shall take effect 61 days after final publication, unless a sufficient petition is filed and a referendum held on the ordinance as provided in Article 12, Section 5 (c) of the Kansas Constitution, in which case the ordinance shall become effective upon approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon.

PASSED AND APPROVED by the Governing Body of the City of Abilene, Kansas by not less than two-thirds of the members elect voting in favor thereon this 12th day of June 2017.
