

RESOLUTION NUMBER 031323-1

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ABILENE FIRE DEPARTMENT'S PARTICIPATION IN THE KANSAS SEARCH AND RESCUE RESPONSE SYSTEM AND APPROVING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE OFFICE OF THE STATE FIRE MARSHALL TO IDENTIFY THE ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF EACH PARTY AS THEY RELATE TO THE DEVELOPMENT AND DEPLOYMENT OF URBAN SEARCH AND RESCUE RESOURCES.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Abilene, Kansas:

Section 1. The City of Abilene Fire Department is authorized to serve and act as a participating agency in the Kansas Search and Rescue Response System for purposes of serving as part of a regional search and rescue team organized for the purpose of responding to search and rescue incidents.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the Office of the State Fire Marshall to identify the roles and responsibilities of each party as they relate to the City of Abilene's participation in the Kansas Search and Rescue Response System and the development and deployment of urban search and rescue resources.

Section 3. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption.
