

ORDINANCE NO. 24-3448

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2828, TITLED “AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE FLUORIDATION OF THE WATER PROVIDED BY THE MUNICIPAL WATER UTILITY”, WHICH WAS PASSED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS ON APRIL 14, 1997 AND BECAME EFFECTIVE ON JULY 10, 1997.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 2828 of the City of Abilene, Kansas is hereby repealed.


SECTION 2. The City Manager is authorized and directed to discontinue the City’s addition of fluoride to water provided by the City’s municipal water utility system.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication once in the official city newspaper by the following summary:


Ordinance No. 24-3448 Summary

On April 22, 2024, the Abilene City Commission passed Ordinance No. 24-3448. The ordinance repeals Ordinance No. 2828, which was titled “AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE FLUORIDATION OF THE WATER PROVIDED BY THE MUNICIPAL WATER UTILITY”, passed by the City Commission on April 14, 1997 and effective on July 10, 1997, and which authorized and directed the fluoridation of water provided by the municipal water utility. 
