

**ORDINANCE NO. 24-3449**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE FLUORIDATION OF THE WATER PROVIDED BY THE MUNICIPAL WATER UTILITY OF THE CITY OF ABILENE KANSAS, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 24-3448.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS:

**SECTION 1.** In order to protect and promote the health of the residents of the City of Abilene, Kansas, the fluoridation of the water provided by the City's municipal water utility is hereby authorized and directed.

**SECTION 2.** The amount and method of fluoridation shall be consistent with all applicable state and federal regulations, as well as standards generally recognized and accepted by the medical and dental professions.


**SECTION 3.** Ordinance No. 24-3448 of the City of Abilene, Kansas is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication once in the official city newspaper by the following summary:


Ordinance No. 24-3449 Summary


