

RESOLUTION NUMBER 011325-1

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS DECLARING A STATE OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on this 13th day of January, 2025, the Governing Body of the City of Abilene, Kansas finds that certain conditions have caused, or eminently threaten to cause, widespread or severe damage, injury or loss of life or property in disaster proportion in the City of Abilene, Kansas;

WHEREAS, the conditions arise from severe winter weather, including heavy snowfall, excessive winds, and extremely low temperatures and windchills in the negative digits;

WHEREAS, such conditions have created obstructions which endanger health, safety, and welfare of persons and property within the borders of the City of Abilene, Kansas;

WHEREAS, a State of Disaster Emergency was proclaimed by the Governor for the State of Kansas in its entirety on January 4, 2025;

WHEREAS, a State of Disaster Emergency was proclaimed by the Board of County Commissioners of Dickinson County, Kansas, for Dickinson County in its entirety, on January 9, 2025;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the Governing Body, under and by virtue of the authority vested in it by K.S.A. 48-932, does hereby proclaim that a State of Local Disaster Emergency exists.


Section 2. That the entire area within the borders of the City of Abilene, Kansas is the area covered by this proclamation and resolution.

Section 3. That the City of Abilene has all rights and/or powers to perform such functions as are vested in the City by and through the provisions of the Kansas Emergency Preparedness Act of 1975.


Section 4. That this resolution shall remain in effect for a period of seven (7) days unless terminated earlier or renewed by the consent of the Governing Body.
