


Summary of Ordinance No. 3200

On August 13, 2012, the City of Abilene, Kansas, adopted Ordinance No. 3200, repealing Ordinance No. 3183, in order to adopt by reference, under the provisions of K.S.A. 12-3009 through 12-3012, and K.S.A. 12-3301 and 12-3302, the "Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities, Edition 2012". The Uniform Public Offense Code provides a comprehensive public offense code for municipalities and, in large part, parallels the state criminal code. ORDINANCE NO. 3200

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE STANDARD CODE IDENTIFIED AS "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES, EDITION OF 2012," AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Be It Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Abilene, Kansas, that:

Section 1. CODE ADOPTION. The standard code known as the "Uniform Public Offense Code for Kansas Cities, Edition of 2012," sponsored by The League of Kansas Municipalities, except such portions as are hereinafter deleted, modified or amended, is hereby incorporated by reference and shall be as much a part of this article as if set out in full herein. The filed copies of the code shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Incorporated by Ordinance No.3201." All sections or portions of the filed copies shall be clearly marked to show deletions or amendments from the standard code.

Section 2. DELETIONS. Sections 6.16, 6.17, 6.19 and 6.20 of the Uniform Public Offense Code as adopted by this ordinance are hereby deleted.

Section 3. REPEAL. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective upon publication in the official city newspaper.
