


### Summary of Ordinance No. 3204

ORDINANCE NO.3204

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18-6 "SUPPLEMENTAL DISTRICT REGULATIONS", OF THE ZONING REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS, RELATING TO HOME OCCUPATIONS

Be it Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Abilene, Kansas, that:

**Section 1.** Section 18-601;d of the Zoning Regulations of the City of Abilene, Kansas, is hereby added to the city zoning code to state as follows:

"Home Child Care Providers may be administratively approved by the Community Development Director provided the proposal conforms to the provisions outlined in Sections 18-10 and 18-603;j. "

**Section 2.** Section 18-603 "Particular Home Occupations Permitted" shall be amended to include new items j, k and l to the Zoning Regulations of the City of Abilene, Kansas, and shall read as follows:

j. Home Child Care Providers shall be allowed in all residential zoning districts provided they are located within a single family residence, and are licensed with the State as stipulated in Section 18-10, and City Code.

k. Personal Chef (No Commercial Catering)

l. Notary Public

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall be effective upon its publication in the official city newspaper.
