


Summary of Ordinance No. 3206

On September 24, 2012, the City of Abilene, Kansas, adopted Ordinance No. 3206, amending Section 5-202 of the City Code, authorizing the consumption of alcohol on city-owned property at designated areas of the Fair Grounds as permitted by the City, except during the Central Kansas Free Fair. ORDINANCE NO. 3206

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5-202 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS, PERTAINING TO THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL ON CITY-OWNED PROPERTY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 5-202 of the City Code of the City of Abilene, Kansas, be amended as follows:

5-202 CONSUMPTION ON CITY PROPERTY. The provisions of Section 5-201 shall not apply to the following city-owned public property:

- a. Abilene Civic Center located in the Union Pacific Passenger Depot;
- b. Senior Center; and
- c. Designated areas at the Fair Grounds as permitted by the City, except that such exemption shall not apply during the Central Kansas Free Fair.

The City Manager shall be empowered to promulgate regulations that may be necessary to ensure the safe consumption of alcohol on City-owned property. Such regulations shall be included in a Memorandum of Understanding to be executed by any party desiring to consume alcohol on City-owned property and shall be subject to the review and approval of the Governing Body.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective and in full force from and after its passage, adoption and publication in the official City newspaper.
