ORDINANCE NO. 3208

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-103 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS, DESIGNATING THE CITY HALL OF ABILENE, KANSAS AS THE DWIGHT D. EISENHOWER MUNICIPAL BUILDING IN HONOR OF PRESIDENT DWIGHT D. EISENHOWER

WHEREAS, President Dwight D. Eisenhower lived in Abilene, Kansas throughout his boyhood years;

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene is the proud home of President Eisenhower's Library and Museum and Boyhood Home;

WHEREAS, no other citizen of the City of Abilene or the State of Kansas has had such an affect on the affairs of the nation and the world as President Dwight D. Eisenhower; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene is eternally proud of the service and honor that President Eisenhower has demonstrated to the world.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 6-103 of the City Code of the City of Abilene, Kansas, be amended as follows:


6-103 CITY HALL. The City Hall of the City of Abilene, Kansas shall hereby be designated as the Dwight D. Eisenhower Municipal Building.

The operation of the City Hall shall be the responsibility of the City Manager, who shall establish rules and regulations for use of the facilities.

SECTION 2. The City Manager shall be empowered to take necessary actions to cause this designation to be fully realized and appreciated by the public.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective and in full force from and after its passage, adoption and publication in the official City newspaper.
