


### Summary of Ordinance No. 3207

**ORDINANCE NO. 3207**

**AN ORDINANCE ADDING NEW SECTION 18-507 and 18-508 RELATING TO SUPPLEMENTAL DISTRICT REGULATIONS, TEMPORARY USES, OF THE CITY OF ABILENE ZONING REGULATIONS (ORDINANCE NO. 2796)**

**Be it Ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Abilene, Kansas, that:**

**Section 1.** Section 18-507 of the Zoning Regulations of the City of Abilene, Kansas, is hereby added to the city zoning code to state as follows:

18-507 Garage, Porch and Yard Sales: Garage, porch, and yard sales of household goods and furnishings are permitted, provided that there shall be no more than five (5) sales per calendar year, not to exceed 48 consecutive hours each in duration.

**Section 2.** Section 18-508 of the Zoning Regulations of the City of Abilene, Kansas, is hereby added to the city zoning code to state as follows:

18-508 Animals at public events : Animals, including Equine and Bovine, pigs, sheep, goats, or other animals customarily found participating in public events such as rodeos, petting zoos, fairs and circuses, are allowed on a temporary basis with the following restrictions during off hours:


1. The animals are adequately housed and sheltered to prevent escape.
2. Animals must be staged within the fairgrounds, or within a B-3, I-1, or I-2 zoning district.


**Section 3.** This ordinance shall be effective upon its publication in the official city newspaper.
